The Design Journey goes around the world: Discover the beauty of nature with the new "Around the World" sets

With the new STAEDTLER Design Journey sets, creative hobbyists can embark on an artistic journey of discovery around the world. The packaging of the sets, which were designed by artists from five continents, provides inspiration. They show natural highlights from each continent and, in addition to the appropriate colour palette, also provide digital courses for drawing the motifs. In addition, the Design Journey Art Class is dedicated to the trends of the new year.

Artistic journey across five continents

The packaging of the new Design Journey "Around the World" sets shows some of the most beautiful natural highlights from five continents, painted by local artists. They encourage people to pick up their own pens and encourage amateur artists to let their creativity run wild. Each set contains six selected colours of the water-soluble double felt-tip pen with brush tip.

Whether the decision falls on the picturesque mountain and meadow landscape of Europe, the tropical coast of Australia, the African savannah, the Andes in South America or paddy field terraces in Asia - each set provides the colours that match the motif. The Design Journey series once again is an invitation to artistically discover beautiful landscapes and be inspired by them. Video tutorials on the STAEDTLER website provide assistance. With them, the works of art from the packaging can be easily drawn even by less experienced hobby artists.

Flowing watercolour effects thanks to two brush tips

The double felt-tip pens contain two tips, a flexible brush tip (approx. 1.0 to 6.0 mm line width) and a fine tip (approx. 0.5 to 0.8 mm line width), which can be used to draw flowing watercolour effects. They are available in 36 colours inspired by nature. The packaging consists of 80% recycled cardboard.

Learn hand lettering with the Design Journey Art Class

Whether the journey takes us through Africa, Australia or the world of art, we always learn something. That's why the Design Journey Art Class offers free online courses for creative hobbyists who want to learn new drawing techniques. A new course on hand lettering will be available on the STAEDTLER website from spring 2024 – two artists will show how lettering can be designed creatively. A video on watercolour painting as well as many other online courses are already available to discover.

Inspired by nature, each artist embarks on their own journey. STAEDTLER offers the right material to work with. The popular Design Journey range is aimed at creative hobbyists who want to try out a wide range of painting and drawing techniques. The range has been continually expanded since its introduction in 2018.
